Arc ZERO: Nimbus, by James Tapscott ON GAZEBO LAKE

Arc ZERO is the 10th iteration of the "Arc" series - culminating a body of work spanning

12 years, created by Australian-based artist James Tapscott. Each arc is a site-determined work beginning as a simple arc - an elegant and perfect form which is then left to a natural process to become transformed into the site. Arc ZERO uses water to produce mist which erupts from the rigid structure and is carried through the air by the wind as a diaphanous temporary form. The ring itself presents as an immersive portal, inviting the viewer to engage physically with the work and experience the site's phenomena in a direct and personal way.



### A New Work, by Thu Kim Vu LAKEVIEW TERRACE

A 2024 Green Box Artist In Residence. Vietnamese based installation artist Thu Kim Vu has created an immersive paper lantern installation on display inside Lakeview Terrace. Thu's work encompasses Vietnamese Zo paper, Japanese Washi, Chinese Ink Brush, and LED light. This ephemeral installation features a series of light sculptures in response to the natural landscape.

### A New Work, by Kristina Barker LAKE STREET DISPLAY

Kristina Barker is a Portland, Oregon based photographer whose artwork created during her 2024 Green Box artist residency will be on view as this summer's Lake Street Display. Kristina's work focuses on our natural world, the climate crisis, and exploring the bewildering experience of existing as a human. During her residency, Kristina embarked on visual explorations of themes around the human experience and calling our souls back home to our bodies through a unique, placebased visual exploration of the landscape.





### Green Mountain Falls Skyspace, by James Turrell RED BUTTE RECREATIONAL AREA

One of Green Box's permanent art installations continues to delight thousands of visitors from throughout the world annually. Turrell's Skyspace offers an open eye to the skyline and stars. The adventure begins with an inspirational journey from the center of town up Red Butte, arriving at a one-of-a-kind kinetic light and color experience that shifts perception of nature and sky through contemporary light and space - an experiential work of art unlike anywhere else in the world.



This summer, Green Box brings FIVE different dance companies to Green Mountain Falls, in a diverse performance featuring styles and rhythms from throughout the world. Each performance will feature work from the following dancers/companies:

Ephrat "Bounce" Asherie, a 2016 Bessie Award ↑ winner for Innovative Achievement in Dance, creates work for the dynamic group of multifaceted dancers in her company Ephrat Asherie Dance (EAD). Rooted in various African American and Latine vernacular dances, including breaking, hip-hop, house and vogue, EAD is dedicated to exploring the inherently complex and dynamic qualities of these forms - Asherie's "movement phrases — compact bursts of choreography with rapid-fire changes in rhythm and gestural articulation — bubble up and dissipate, quickly paving the way for something new" (The NY Times).
\*Note: Ephrat will only be appearing through July 7th

GALLIM Dance is a modern dance company founded in 2007 by groundbreaking choreographer Andrea Miller. GALLIM is a home for the exchange of movement wisdom through the three pillars of art-making, education, and community-building. GALLIM nurtures creative careers and stimulates the imagination of worldwide audiences through performance, education, and innovation in the movement arts, envisioning a world where creativity, movement and art is accessible, valued and serving its role of communicating the experience of our times.

Michela Marino Lerman, winner of the Hoofer and FloBert Awards, is a world renowned tap dance artist, performer, choreographer, band leader, educator and all-around creative spirit. The NY Times has called her both a "prodigy" and has described her dancing as "flashes of brilliance." Michela will be performing with Russell Hall, one of the most in-demand bass players in New York City.

Jesús Muñoz Flamenco has, for over 10 years, worked to preserve and innovate the uniquely improvisational language of Flamenco art while enriching communities through multi-generational participation in the arts. The company, founded in 2010 in Albuquerque, has developed a physical, visual and sonic vocabulary that intersects Flamenco with Latin, Jazz and Hip-Hop, reflecting the experiences and backgrounds of company artists and audiences.

Barkha Patel is a kathak dancer, choreographer, educator, and the Artistic Director of Barkha Dance Company based in New York City. Barkha has performed solo and ensemble works at dance festivals in India and the U.S. Barkha was recently awarded the 2023 Juried Bessie Award for "elegantly and magnificently creating, educating, and sharing work that elevates classical Indian and Kathak dance. Patel is deeply rooted in her art form's spiritual and cultural history and is a contemporary voice that will contribute to the evolution of Kathak dance and its place in the dance world at large."

Highlighting our annual 4th of July Block Party, Green Box is thrilled to welcome Stillhouse Junkies back to Green Mountain Falls, following their artist residency in 2023. A crowd-thrilling trio, the Durango-bred band offer up a hypnotic and high-energy form of roots music anchored in the free-flowing interplay among the three lifelong musicians (Fred Kosak on guitar and mandolin, Cody Tinnin on upright bass, Alissa Wolf on fiddle). While they've gained major traction in the bluegrass world in recent years — including winning the IBMA Momentum Band

of the Year award in 2021—Stillhouse Junkies ultimately inhabit a genre - blurring and subtly inventive sound informed by everything from blues to classical to Texas swing.




### Dalí Quartet
